Whereas, The Student Senate has an annual responsibility of ensuring certified organizations and university departments are funded properly in order for the clubs and organizations to function in a capacity that is in the best interest of the student body, and

Whereas, The FAMU-CAP program is a 'think-tank' laboratory for all FAMU students to explore creative research through educational enrichment experiences and is a mentoring program to enhance the encouragement of students with hands on art and science collaborative ideas and interdisciplinary global perspectives, and

Whereas, The program focus of CAP celebrates the historical legacy of the university and new examples for Agricultural and Mechanical objectives, and supports university retention and the recruitment of more incoming students that are interested in creating new unique art and artifacts signature to the promotion of FAMU and the enrollment of students, and

Whereas, The FAMU-CAP is in need of funding to follow through with the initiatives of the program that includes their yearly art and research calendar, Art Basel Conference, Community Murals, and Visiting Scholars, now

Therefore, Be it appropriated that the Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate allocates nine thousand two hundred and ninety two dollars

and ninety cents (9,292.90) to the FAMU-CAP to assist with the cost of their programs initiatives.
