**Title: IDSC Big/Little Mentoring Program
Legislation: SB21SP-002**

Whereas,	The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University (Florida A&M) Student Government Association is the governing entity of the Student Body, and is empowered to work for the betterment of the general welfare of the Student Body, to express the general interest of the Student Body, and to provide for full student participation in student government; and
Whereas,	The IDSC must strive to aid all new senators in the best way possible through creative initiatives and giving the senate the opportunity to create bonding experiences.
Whereas,	The past IDSC Chairs have already made it their personal duty to implement the Big/Little Mentoring program, allowing experienced senators to mentor new senators.
Whereas,	One of the most important benefits of becoming a mentor (“Big”) is that it allows you to positively change the life of a younger individual (“Little”). When Bigs defend, ignite, and empower their Little's potential, they are helping to ensure that they receive their brightest future possible.
Therefore,	Be it Enacted, that IROP Section 2.4 Committee Chairperson's Powers and Duties amended as follows: B. The purpose of IDSC 1. To make recommendations to the Senate Executive Committee for Senate improvements.

	<p>2. To aid all new Senators in the Student Senate through creative initiatives (i.e. mentoring assignments and group team building games).</p> <p>3. To maintain Senate facilities and entertain recommendations for Senate facility enhancement.</p> <p>4. To solicit Senate meeting speakers to inform Senators and student body on the status of various entities on campus (i.e. the Director of Financial Services or the University President).</p> <p>5. To plan and organize an end-of-the-year banquet if funding and time permits.</p> <p>6. To spearhead training initiatives for the Senate and officially orient newly confirmed Senators regarding Senate documents, procedures, and functions.</p> <p>7. To create a Big/Little mentoring program, pairing an experienced senator with a newly elected/appointed senator.</p>
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Proviso Language: The legislation shall take effect immediately upon signage by the Student Body President.


