Please see the content of Executive Order 001, which addresses the Judicial Branch Leadership appointments and Judicial Branch vacancies. Should you have any questions, do not hesitate to contact me so that your concerns may be resolved.

Executive Order Content

Section 1 | Authority

Per the power vested in me by the Student Body Constitution in Article IV: Section 5 Subpoint D.

“Appoint the Chief Justice, Associate Chief Justice, and Justices to the Judicial Branch of the Student Supreme Court and Traffic Court when vacancies exist, subject to Student Senate approval by a two-third (2/3) vote.”

I have chosen to appoint Melissa Lavoile and Titilayo Okuwa as the Student Supreme Court Chief Justice and Associate Chief Justice for the 2019-2020 academic year. These appointments are subject to Student Senate approval by a two-thirds (2/3) vote in the Fall semester. Furthermore, the Judicial Branch vacancies will be advertised from August 5th to the 16th. Interviews will be granted to qualified candidates between August 19th to the 23rd. A list of appointments will be forwarded to the 49th Student Senate President, President Pro-Tempore and Elections and Appointments Committee Chairperson by August 26, 2019. The vacancies are as followed: Four Supreme Court Justices, Solicitor General of the Supreme Court, Clerk of Courts, and three Traffic Court Justices.

Section 2 | Purpose

It is critical that the SGA is fully composed to operate efficiently and effectively throughout the academic year. Additionally, the Fall semester student elections cannot begin without quorum on the Supreme Court and confirmed Solicitor General. The aforementioned appointment timeline provides the best timeframe to complete these actions without inhibiting our student processes.

Section 3 | Action Items

- A. Responsibility
 - a. The following actions items shall be the responsibility of Alexys Lynn, the appointed Chief of Staff, or her designee.
- B. Graphic Request (Deadline August 4, 2019)
 - a. Please complete a graphic request to advertise the vacancies:
 - i. (4) Supreme Court Justices, (1) Solicitor General of the Supreme Court, (1) Clerk of Courts, and (3) Traffic Court Justices
 - ii. Application Time Period: August 5, 2019 through August 16, 2019
 - iii. Application Deadline: August 16, 2019 at 5:00pm
 - iv. Target a convenient date for the graphic to be completed
- C. Judicial Branch Application (Deadline August 4, 2019)
 - a. Responsibility
 - i. The following actions items shall be the responsibility of myself and Alexia Bell, the Web Content Manager
 - b. Find the Judicial Branch Application and develop a new application for the 2019-2020 academic year. This application and application process should contain the best course of action for accessing and submitting the application, with as little complications as possible.
- D. Judicial Branch Interview Schedule (Deadline August 16, 2019)
 - a. Responsibility
 - i. The following action items shall be my responsibility.
 - b. Develop an interview schedule that best fits the schedules of Melissa Lavoile, the appointed Chief Justice, Titilayo Okuwa, the appointed Associate Chief Justice, and Natalie Antenor, the Student Body Vice President. This timeline should be from August 19th to the 23rd.
- E. Judicial Branch Appointments (Deadline August 26, 2019)
 - a. Responsibility
 - i. The following action items shall be my responsibility.
 - b. Submit a list of Judicial Branch appointments to the 49th Student Senate President and Election and Appointments Committee Chairwoman by August 26, 2019.
