Please see the content of Executive Order 003, which addresses the appointment of Malachi Somerville as the SGA Photographer for the academic year. Should you have any questions, do not hesitate to contact me so that your concerns may be resolved.

Executive Order Content

Section 1 | Authority

Per the power vested in the appointed-Secretary of Communications Mr. William McKay by the Student Body Statutes in Title XIII Chapter 1203.1:

The RROWT shall be composed of the following:

- 1. Group of students at large shall be appointed by the Secretary of Communications, with one student serving as the official photographer of Student Government Association and be subjected to the approval of the Student Body Senate by majority vote.*

Per the power vested in me by the Student Body Statutes in Title II chapter 102.6:

Students appointed to the Executive Branch Cabinet shall not be official members of Student Government Association until their confirmation. Any official actions taken, or plans made on behalf of Student Government by an appointed but non-confirmed student shall be sanctioned in writing by the SGA President and SGA Director. Any official actions to be taken or plans to be made which are pending approval of the SGA President, SGA Director, or Vice President of Student Affairs shall become null and void should the appointed student fail final confirmation by the Student Senate.

I am pleased to approve this action taken by Mr. William McKay.

Section 2 | Purpose

The purpose of appointing a SGA Photographer/Videographer is to maintain photos of our current members and attend all SGA events/functions to capture the programming of SGA on film and make it available on the SGA website and social media channels. This is a critical appointment because often times in recent years, our events are not properly captured or communicated with our successors. This appointment will attempt to resolve this lingering issue. We will also utilize Mr. Somerville in dynamic ways this year to effectively communicate with our constituents.

Section 3 | Action Items

Mr. Somerville is subject to Senate approval by majority vote. This has been communicated with Senate President Miller and will be done promptly.
