The purpose of this correspondence is to provide an update on the status of the College of Law Circuit Court appointments for the 2019-2020 academic year. Over the summer, I provided an update to the Student Bar Association President Jonathan Monk and Vice President Elliot Jackson on the changes made to the constitution and statutes. I asked that they create a timeline to advertise the Law School Circuit Court and I asked for their recommendations based on the pool of applicants.

The applicants that I did receive did not meet the basic requirements to be a part of the Student Government Association due to GPAs and part-time student enrollment status. This was due to an error on my part because I did not put the requirements on the applications. Thus, those candidates were denied.

Moving forward, I am still awaiting students to apply for the law school circuit court. So far, I only have one applicant. I will follow up with their leadership to ensure that more students are applying so that I can name a full circuit court as soon as possible.
