NOTICE OF INVESTIGATION: Notice is hereby given that, formal investigation into the Student Senate's motion to impeach President Bruno and Vice President Harrison was initiated on March 24, 2017.

AUTHORITY: The authority for institution of this investigation is contained in Chapter 203, §203.5 of the Student Body Statutes (2015).

SUMMARY: On February 6, 2017, the Student Senate made a motion to impeach President Bruno and Vice President Harrison. On February 8, 2017, Senate President, Brandon Johnson, wrote a memorandum providing a basis for said motion to impeach. The basis for the motion to impeach is that President Bruno and Vice President Harrison willfully cooperated with the former Electoral Commissioner, Adrienne Floyd, in the breach of section 602.4 (C), Student Body Statutes; Florida board of Governors regulation 6.014 (7); and section 1004.26 (4) (a-b), Florida Statutes.

SCOPE OF INVESTIGATION: During this investigation, the following issues will be examined:

1. Whether impeachment was properly initiated; and
2. Whether a breach of section 602.4 (C), Student Body Statutes; Florida board of Governors regulation 6.014 (7); and section 1004.26 (4) (a-b), Florida Statutes occurred.
