Title: FAMU Dubai/South Africa Study Abroad Program

Whereas,	The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association, and
Whereas,	Florida A&M University has made it one of their main focal points in recent years to put FAMU students on the path to globalization in an effort to make them more competitive with other institution's students in a globalizing society, and
Whereas,	Globalization demands a new generation of university graduates who are equipped to lead the global community; this opportunity allows students to develop strategies and solutions that will eliminate health and economic disparities of minorities through cultural immersion and exchange, and
Whereas,	This trip will provide a combination of a cultural exchange while at the same time exposing students to employment opportunities not only in the United States, but overseas as well, now
Therefore,	Be it Appropriated Thirty-five thousand, eight hundred dollars (\$35,800) to the Spring Global Immersion Experience Program.
