Whereas, The African Student Association lacks the funding to host the annual African Student Association Showcase. Said to spread cultural awareness and highlight the mass influence of Africans through the world, the showcase features a well-known Nigerian Comedian who will serve as the host of the event. The showcase is said to highlight the true talents and positivity of Africa through various media, exposing students to the heart of the Motherland,

Whereas, The purpose of the African Students Association is to showcase the mass influence of Africans throughout the world while also providing a home away from home for students of African descent and those interested in African culture,

Therefore, **Be it Appropriated,** four thousand, six hundred-fifty dollars (**\$4,650.00**) to fund the African Student Association Annual Showcase.
