Whereas,	The Association of Black Psychologists is a beneficial organization with rich history founded on the resolution of focusing on the concerns beneficial to Blacks in both the Professional and personal aspect of psychology. And
Whereas,	The organization is holding its 50 th Convention in Oakland, California which will give the amazing rattlers an opportunity to learn about the most interesting mental topics correlating to the Black community. And
Whereas,	Having the opportunity will not only allow our rattlers to travel across the country to represent their love for their HBCU, but also allow for them to gain knowledge which can spark and support other rattlers that struggle with psychological issues through events and seminars discussed at the annual convention.
Therefore,	<u>Be it allocated</u> \$8,800 to the Association of Black Psychologists to attend their national conference and represent rattlers in a bright light towards addressing mental health and the professional world of Psychology.
