Whereas, The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association, and

Whereas, The purpose of the Florida A&M University Naval ROTC is to develop midshipmen mentally, morally and physically and to imbue them with the highest ideals of duty, and loyalty, and with the core values of honor, courage and commitment in order to commission college graduates as naval officers who possess a basic professional background, are motivated toward careers in the naval service, and have a potential for future development in mind and character so as to assume the highest responsibilities of command, citizenship and government, and

Whereas, The FAMU Naval ROTC plans on showcasing their leadership and tactical abilities at a few drill meets and challenges. They also plan on hosting their own events not only to showcase what they can do but to recruit incoming high school JROTC students from the surrounding area. Finally, they will be hosting their annual military ball where they will be able to convene as one and present awards to Naval ROTC members in specific categories, and

Whereas, These opportunities will benefit the Naval ROTC as a whole because they will be able give the organization a chance to not only showcase their talent and abilities, but also recruit incoming rattlers to keep their tradition going, now

Therefore, **Be it Appropriated, nine thousand dollars (9,000) to the FAMU Naval ROTC for their participation in drill meets and challenges as well as their annual military ball.**

Proviso Language: This piece of legislation will take effect upon signage by the Student Body President. The original request value was for \$12,245.50 and the organization qualified for 80% based on the funding rubric.
