Whereas, The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association, and

Whereas, The FAMU section of American Society of Agricultural and Biological Engineers (ASABE) is an accredited organization by the Board of Engineering and Technology, dedicated to training competitive individuals enrolled in the Biological System Engineering (BSE) program within the College of Agriculture and Food Sciences (CAFS) for well over a decade, and

Whereas, A lack of funding from the CAFS hinders the chance BSE students have to attend the ASABE Southeast Regional Student Rally and Annual International Meeting, two annual conferences where BSE students have the opportunity to further their academic development by competing in design projects and presentations, strengthen their network by interacting with representatives from different leading universities along with leading engineering industries, and

Whereas, The ASABE Southeast Regional Student Rally and ASABE Annual International Meeting prepares BSE students with the knowledge and resources to make a global impact; by exposing students to the latest ideals and endeavors of successful Agriculture Engineers, BSE students can focus on solving renown global issues, advancing the living conditions of people across the world, and discovering innovative ways to improve agriculture production, now

Therefore, **Be it Appropriated, nine thousand seven hundred and seventy dollars (\$9,770.00) to fund the ASABE SE Southeast Regional Student Rally and the ASABE Annual International Meeting.**
