Whereas, The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association, and

Whereas, FAMU's Office of New Student Orientation (NSO) coordinates programs that are designed to facilitate a student's transition into FAMU. NSO offers the opportunity for students to learn about the policies and procedures that regulate the university and receive information about the services and organizations that are available to students, and

Whereas, The Office of New Student Orientation also sponsors the universities orientation team. The Orientation Leader position is highly respected at Florida A&M University. These carefully selected students have the primary responsibility of helping first- year students make a smooth transition into FAMU by serving as resources and role models for the newest members of our rattler community. Subsequently, FAMU's orientation leaders have over the years placed first place in school spirit and in the skit competition at the Southern Regional Orientation Workshop, and

Whereas, NSO is seeking funding to send their 2019 Orientation Leader Candidates to the annual Southern Regional Orientation Workshop held on March 15- 18, 2019 in South Carolina. The purpose of this Conference is to provide education, leadership and professional development in the fields of college student orientation, transition, and retention. NSO is also looking for the senate to sponsor orientation shirts for the incoming freshman for the class of 2023. Lastly, the orientation office plans to sponsor a brand new inflatable tunnel for the football team to have at home and away games. These opportunities will not only benefit the students who work directly with the orientation office, but the university as a whole, and

Therefore, **Be it Appropriated, Twelve thousand two hundred and seventy-seven dollar (12,277.50) to the Office of New Student Orientation for transportation to the Southern Regional Orientation Workshop in South Carolina, Class of 2023 orientation shirts, and rattler athletic inflatable.**

Proviso Language: *This piece of legislation will take effect upon signage by the Student Body President. The original request value was for \$29,870 and the organization qualified for 100% based on the funding rubric. The 49th Student Senate President will pay for up to \$6,162.50 for the T-shirt line-item.*
