Whereas, Strikers Dance Troupe Inc. has been a corner stone feature of Florida A&M since its founding in February of 1989. The purpose of this organization is to unite and uplift brotherhood to African-American males, while promoting self-confidence and a positive image through dance and comedy routines. They have performed all across the United States in cities such as Chicago, Miami, and New York. And have produced notable alumni such as Woody McClain.

Whereas, The Strikers would like to travel to Miami, Florida to hold dance classes for high school students at Miami Carol City High School and to dance in the matinee performance. The organization is in need of funds travel and hotel fees.

Whereas, Student Governments support of the Strikers Dance Troupe will encourage the overall morale of the FAMU Student Body, and allow the Student Senate to invest in the utilization of the prominent dance troupe as a recruitment tool in addition to furthering their exposure.
