Whereas, The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association, and

Whereas, The Office of International Education and Development (OIED) was established in June 2003. Throughout the office’s tenure on campus it has welcomed over 5,000 international students and scholars and sent thousands of students abroad. The mission of OIED is to foster campus internationalization and raise awareness of the value of international education, inclusion, and intercultural diversity. and

Whereas, FAMU’s Strategic Priority 1 is Exceptional Student Experience Student success. “We will increase student success and improve the overall student experience by enhancing academic support services, strengthening our academic degree programs, enhancing our living-learning environment, and promoting innovative co-curricular activities.” and

Whereas, Providing 50 passports will make a lasting impact on FAMU students pursuing international education and will align with the University’s strategic priority efforts and the The Office of International Education and Development’s mission statement.

Therefore, **Be it Appropriated,** seven-thousand two hundred & fifty dollars and zero cents (\$7,250) to fund 50 free passports for FAMU students interested in traveling and/or studying abroad.

Proviso Language: This piece of legislation will take effect upon signage by the Student Body President.
