Title: FAMU Entertainment, Arts, and Sports Law Society Allocation Bill
Legislation: Senate Appropriation Bill

Whereas, The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out the functions of the Student Government Association, and

Whereas, EASLS is comprised of students interested in the fields of sports and entertainment law. The EASLS, as a whole, is committed to promoting awareness of and pursuing careers in these areas. EASLS has been an important organization in facilitating networking opportunities between the FAMU College of Law students and the legal community.

Whereas, EASLS is requesting money for their Annual 2020 Entertainment, Arts, and Sports Law Symposium in March. The Symposium aims to bring together industry professionals with FAMU Law students for networking and internship opportunities. This program traditionally consists of sports and entertainment law professionals, who engage in meaningful conversations regarding the business, legal, ethical, and professional issues facing their respective fields. The event is expected to have strong attendance and interaction from notable attorneys and experts in these fields. This year, the symposium categories will include professional ethics, fashion and intellectual property, sports law and agency management, and advising for new lawyers and law students. The symposium is an all day event that will be open to the public (for a small fee) and all FAMU students, faculty, and staff (free).

Whereas, Student Governments support of the EASLS will encourage the overall morale of the FAMU Student Body, and allow the Student Senate to invest in establishing a professional identity for FAMU Law in the realm of Entertainment Law.

Therefore, Be it Appropriated, \$6,000 to the EASLS for their Annual Entertainment Law Symposium on March 7, 2020.
