Title: Honoring the life of Jacqueline Beck, Ph.D

Whereas,	The Florida Agricultural & Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out functions for the benefit of the Student Body and on behalf of the Student Government Association, and
Whereas,	Unfortunately, the founding Dean of Allied Health, Jacqueline Beck, Ph.D., passed away on October 31 st 2017. Beck left a legacy on the campus of Florida A&M University that will be cherished for years to come, and
Whereas,	Jacqueline Beck, Ph.D., began her career at FAMU in 1958 as a nursing instructor and eventually became an associate professor and acting Dean of the School of Nursing. In 1978, she was entrusted with developing the proposal that led to the creation of the School of Allied Health Sciences in 1982. Beck served as Dean of the School of Allied Health Sciences until 2000. To commemorate her many contributions and dedication to the University, in 2007, the building that houses FAMU's Allied Health Sciences programs (Lewis-Beck Building) was named in her honor, and
Whereas,	Jacqueline Beck, Ph.D., deserves to be recognized for her diligence and invaluable contributions to the lives of students, faculty, and the Rattler nation, now
Therefore,	Be it resolved that the Student Government Association and Student Body as a whole recognizes and honors Jacqueline Beck, Ph.D., for her magnanimous efforts, and the indelible mark she has left on the campus of Florida A&M University and throughout the Tallahassee community.
