
Title: Black Out Loud Week

Legislation: Senate Resolution Bill

Whereas,	The Florida Agricultural & Mechanical University Student Senate is the Legislative Branch of the Student Government Association and is empowered to pass legislation as it deems necessary to carry out functions for the benefit of the Student Body and on behalf of the Student Government Association, and
Whereas,	The Student Government Association is the most prominent leadership organization that represents the students of Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University and The Student Senate Student Relations Committee has the responsibility to plan, organize, and execute projects and activities in order to increase pride and awareness amongst the student body, and
Whereas,	“Black Out Loud” Week shall be a stapled week of events for the student body of Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University bringing awareness of Black History Month to the campus through song, dance, food, and entertainment, and
Whereas,	The planning and execution of “Black Out Loud” week shall be the responsibility of the Student Relations Committee with the expectations that other senators will help assist with volunteer efforts as needed.
Therefore,	Be it resolved that the Student Government Association deems the second week in February “Black Out Loud” week and annually allocate discretionary funds to The Student Relations Committee as needed.
