Whereas, Since its inception on June 1, 1946, the Incomparable Marching 100 has been a pioneer in the performing arts realm and has reshaped the world's concept of collegiate marching band. The Marching 100 has had many notable performances and is the only historically black university band to receive the "Sudler Intercollegiate Marching Band Trophy". In 2017, the Marching 100 was invited to participate in the 2019 Tournament of Roses Parade in Pasadena, California, and

Whereas, The opportunity to march in the 2019 Tournament of Roses Parade proved to be a challenge both fiscally and logistically, and

Whereas, In the face of adversity, the Marching 100 galvanized the Rattler community and was able to raise an incredible amount of money to fund this endeavor. Additionally, the Marching 100 leadership strategically developed and executed a plan to resolve the logistical challenges of this endeavor,

Therefore, **Be it Resolved,** that the Florida A&M University Student Government Association and student body recognize the hard work and commitment of the Marching 100 as well as its outstanding performance at the 2019 Tournament of Roses Parade in Pasadena, California.
