Whereas, The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University (Florida A&M University) Student

Government Association is the governing entity of the Student Body, and is empowered to express the general interest of the Student Body, and to provide for full student

participation in student government; and

Whereas, According to Section 1 of the XV Amendment to the United States Constitution, "The

right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any state on account of race, color, or previous condition of servitude", and

Whereas, According to the U.S. Bureau of Justice Statistics and the Sentencing Project, Florida

has the highest disenfranchisement rate in the United States with over 10.4% of the Florida population disenfranchised as compared to 2.47% of the total population of the United States, with over 21% of Black citizens (~500,000 citizens) disenfranchised in

Florida, and

Whereas, The Governor of Florida, Ron DeSantis recently tweeted from his official account that

"Voting is a privilege", a harmful public statement, rooted in the historical

discrimination of minority groups' participation in the right to vote, and

Whereas, Florida A&M University, as the only Historically Black University within the State

University System of Florida, has an inherent responsibility to stand up for the voices

of minority citizens within the State of Florida, now

Therefore, Be it resolved that the Florida A&M University Student Government Association on

behalf of the Student Body strongly states that voting should be considered a right in an advanced, inclusive democracy, and cautions against the dangerous rhetoric that the

right to vote should be a privilege.

Proviso Language: This piece of legislation will, upon signage by the Student Body President, and upon approval by the Florida A&M University administration, be officially disseminated to the FAMUAN and other local news sources, as well as the Florida Supreme Court, The office of the Governor, and all other relevant entities.
